

"If producers in Pakistan increase production of olive oil and pay attention to the quality of oil they produce, they will find Italy an interesting market for olive oil from Pakistan," he said.

The official said Italy had been an export success story for Pakistan, adding that last year, Pakistan's exports to Italy were to the tune of \$1.2 billion.

an adequate policy that supports the rural development of the olive sector. National Project Director for the Promotion of Olive Cultivation on a planted in 20 districts of Balochistan,

which was the most suitable place for growing olives. In contrast, 10 olive trees are planted per second in the world. Olive oil is produced in 66 countries, whereas it is consumed in 198 countries, Dr Tariq said.

He also disclosed that Pakistan is no longer importing olive tree saplings from Italy, Spain, or elsewhere, but the saplings are now developed under a governmentfunded project and supplied to growers all over the country, thus saving precious foreign exchange.

Highlighting the current situation of olives in Pakistan and the untapped potential of olive cultivation, Dr Tariq said Pakistan had been identified as a favourable country for olive cultivation and would soon become a member of the 'International Olive Council'.

Dr Tariq said Pakistan was chronically deficient in edible oil production and was importing 80pc of its domestic requirements.

Consequently, a huge amount of foreign exchange is being spent on its

import, he said, adding that olive cultivation in Pakistan had the potential to not only stop oil imports but also export premium oil.

The total olive plantation in Pakistan is about 45,000 acres across the country under various programmes. It is estimated that 15pc of the plants are at the fruiting stage as of now. Around 110 tonnes of loive oil and 40 tonnes of fruit were value-added, generating an economic activity of R-300 million during the fiscal year 2022-23, which has resulted in the creation of jobs in resource-poor rural areas, the development of various start-ups and entrepreneurs exuding health benefits and the mitigation and adaptation of the changing climate.

During the two-day event, an olive oil organoleptic competition will be held, and awards will be given to the top 20 progressive olive farmers and three scientists for best field performance, best packaging and best bottling for quality olive oil.

Pakistan to launch 'PakOlive' as brand name for olive oil

ISLAMABAD: As the olive sector is developing fast, with about 18,600 hectares of land has been brought under olive cultivation across the country, Pakistan is launching a brand of olive oil to be known as 'PakOlive'.

The Pakistan brand of olive oil will be launched at the two-day 'National Gala' at F-9 Park in Islamabad on Saturday to mark 'World Olive Tree Day'. The Minister for National Food Security and Research Dr Kausar Abdullah Malik, and the Ambassador of Italy Andreas Ferrarese, will be the main speakers at the national gala.

Pakistan has been identified as a favourable country for olive cultivation, will soon become a member of the International Olive Council (IOC), and will be among the biggest olive-producing countries in the next few years.

The National Project Director of PakOlive, Dr Mohammad Tariq, will speak on the current scenario of olive sector in Pakistan, while the Project Coordinator of the 'OliveCulure Project' will explain the Italian involvement in enhancing the olive value chain in Pakistan. PakOlive is a project of the government, administered by the Ministry of National Food Security and Research.

According to Dr Mohammad Tariq, an estimated 110 tonnes of olive oil are being produced annually from 32 olive extraction units installed all over the country. Pakistan has almost 4 million hectares of uncultivated, poor-productive land that can be brought under olive cultivation, Dr Tariq said.

Achieving self-reliance in this potential area is one of the linchpins of the whole value chain. As a result, depend-

ency on imported olive nursery plants has concluded due to project interventions in certified nursery raising techniques and demonstrating the improved infrastructure.

For enhanced profitability to the farmers and stakeholders, three value-added laboratories were established for olive product development and its demonstration at the Agricultural Research Institute, Peshawar, the Barani Agricultural Research Institute, Chakwal, and the Agricultural Research Institute, Balochistan. Consequently, more than 20 startup entrepreneurs in the olive sector have started trading various olive products in the market.

According to Dr Tariq, the olive sector is facing four major challenges, which are crop-specific extension services, certified skilled technicians and manpower, machinery and equipment, and business advisory.

Pakistan is now moving towards establishing the Pakistan Olive Oil Council, an association for quality control, labeling, and good manufacturing practices; fostering partnerships in the emerging olive sector; and strengthening connections with international organisations like the International Olive Council.

Olive oil, also known as 'liquid gold', has many health benefits, and its consumption is linked to improved heart health, anti-inflammatory properties, weight management, and being high in antioxidants. Extra virgin olive oil has phenolic compounds that have chemotherapeutic, anti-ageing, neuro-protective, and anti-rheumatic effects and prevent diabetes.

On the second day of the national gala, awards will be given to the top twenty progressive olive farmers and the three best scientists for best field performance. Olive stakeholders will set up stalls showcasing olive oil and olive products.
